We are writing to urge the release from prison of 23 prominent Turks who, shortly after the election, were sentenced to between five and eight years hard labor for their involvement in the Turkish Peace Association (TPA).

The average age of the TPA's executive prisoners is over 50. They include former ambassador Mahmut Dikerdem, age 68 and suffering from cancer, Orhan Apaydin, age 56, president of the Istanbul Bar Association who has one functioning kidney and heart disease, the president of the Turkish Medical Association, professors, former social democratic members of the Turkish Parliament, journalists, and other equally prominent public figures.

We note with considerable concern that the appeals procedure in the TPA trial has been blocked by the military tribunal. We are especially concerned about the state of the health of Mr. Dikerdem and Mr. Apaydin. The verdicts can be regarded as de facto death sentences for these aging and ailing men.

In addition, we are troubled by the human rights questions which arise from the trial and imprisonment of these TPA members. It appears that Turkey is in violation of Articles 10 and 11 of the European Convention on Human Rights, to which Turkey is a party, which protect the right to the freedoms of expression, peaceful assembly, and association with others, and the exercise of these rights.

We urge the government of Turkey, on both humanitarian grounds and as evidence of its movement toward becoming a democratic society, to immediately and unconditionally release the 23 TPA prisoners.

Thank you for your attention to this important matter, and for your consideration. We respectfully look forward to your early reply.
