Dear President Evren,

On the 19th of November 1987 the European Parliament had asked your Government to release immediately Mr. Haydar KUTLU, general secretary of the Communist Party of Turkey and Mr. Nihat SARGIN, president of the Labour Party of Turkey, on behalf of their resolution.

On the 5th of December, after 19 days in incommunicado detention, the Ankara State Security Court committed Mister Nihat Sargin and Mister Haydar Kutlu to prison after charging them with a number of offences, including "leading membership of illegal organisation", "making communist propaganda". During the 19 days of incommunicado detention, the two Secretary Generals had been submitted at torture : electric shocks, hanging, beatings, being stripped naked, deprived of sleep and being forced to drink water doctored with drugs.

These facts contradict the claims of your government to have restored democracy in the country and harm the image of Turkey in the European Community.

If Turkey really claims to be a democratic state system, based on human rights it is necessary to :

- 1) ban the articles 141 and 142 of the Turkish Penal Law
- 2) respect the Declaration of Human Rights
- 3) release immediately Mister Kutlu and Mister Sargin who are accused to be member and lead the Communist and Workers Party, the which are present and allowed in all the democratic countries
- 4° an impartial investigation shall be carried out into allegations that Haydar Kutlu and Nihat Gargin were ill treated during interrogation.
