Dear Comrades,

7th anniversary of Socialist Workers' Party of Turkey will be celebrated by a rally on 13 June 1981 at Haus der Jugend, Deutschherrenufer 12, 6000 Frankfurt a.M, at 15<sup>00</sup>.

Socialist Workers' Party of Turkey (SWPT), founded legally in 1974, firmly stands for scientific socialism and proletarian internationalism and subscribes to the views and theses contained in the documents of International Meetings of Communist and Workers' Parties of 1957, 1960 and 1969 as well as of Regional Conferences of 1975 in Havana and 1976 in Berlin. SWPT has up to now waged a principled and resolute struggle against Maoism, Trotskysm and all other kinds of right and "left" deviation.

After the coup d'état of September 1980 in Turkey, SWPT has passed on to illegal party activity. Since it is impossible at the moment to celebrate the anniversary of our Party legally in Turkey, the Political Bureau has arranged a celebration rally in Federal Germany where about two million Turkish workers live presently.

Socialist Workers' Party of Turkey strives to realize the formation in Turkey of an anti-fascist democratic front under the leadership of the working class. Our aim is to make this gathering the occasion of a new step-forward in securing unity of action against the military dictatorship in Turkey.

Your participation will have great importance for all communist and progressive forces of Turkey struggling against the military dictatorship.
