Dear Comrades,

The anniversary of Socialist Workers' Party of Turkey will be celebrated by a rally on 13 June 1981 at Haus der Jugend, Deutschherren-Ufer 12, 6000 Frankfurt a.M. at 15⁰⁰.

After the coup d'état of September 1980 in Turkey, our Party (SWPT) which firmly stands for scientific socialism and proletarian internationalism, has passed on to illegal party activity. Since it is impossible at the moment to celebrate the anniversary of our Party legally in Turkey, the Political Bureau has arranged a celebration rally in Federal Germany where about 1.5 million Turkish and Kurdish workers live presently.

Delegations of the most advanced political parties of Turkey have been invited to the rally. Your participation will have great importance for all communist and progressive forces of Turkey struggling against the Junta.
